

# Getting to the University of York

## By foot

Following the walking route indicated on the York map, Market Square on Heslington West is about 2.5 miles (4km) from York Railway Station.

## By bicycle

From York Railway Station it is around a 20 minute cycle ride to Heslington West. The University has a network of cycle paths and there are cycle racks in most parts of campus.

## By bus

There is a frequent bus service to the campus from York Railway Station in the city centre which takes about 20 minutes.

## By car


We recommend drivers approach the University from the junction of the A64 and A1079 to the east of the city, from where the University is signposted. Visitors should park in one of the ticketed car parks on Heslington East or West, marked on the map. Access to parking for Heslington East, including the Ron Cooke Hub, is via the road signposted to Grimston Bar Park and Ride on the A1079. From Grimston Bar Park and Ride follow the signage to Heslington East.

## By train

There is a frequent, fast train service to York on the main East Coast Line from London King's Cross to Edinburgh. There is also a direct service between York, Leeds and Manchester Airport. The University is a short bus or taxi ride direct from York Railway Station.
